Old Business

- Kent Wallace requested \$300.00, for Cub Scouts, pack 199. This was approved.

- Ms. Long shared that 5th grade has been working on state assessments and has gotten a lot of use out of the Chrome Books. Also, Camp Eastwood is coming up, June 2-4. And the end of the Celebration/Graduation is also coming up and is an exciting time for students.

Open Forum

- Garden Beds- a question was asked about the garden beds that were made last year, and what was happening with that project. Mrs. Opp shared that our OHSU extension teacher will be helping with that project.

Principal's Report

- Mrs. Opp shared that 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades were working hard on the state test. Students will each spend a total of 7 hours completing their test.
